
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY  
TRANSFERS TO DEPLETED FUNDS**


**WHEREAS**, IC 36-1-8-4(a) allows the Town by resolution to permit the transfer of a prescribed amount, for a prescribed period, to a depleted fund in need of money for cash flow purposes from another fund of the political subdivision;


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE, BROWN COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS DUE TO THE DELAYS IN RECEIVING TAX FUNDS AND THE CLERK-TREASURER IS AUTHORIZED TO TRANSFER FUNDS AS NECESSARY IN ACCORDANCE WITH IC 36-1-8-4(a) AND NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 AND TO BE REPAID BY DECEMBER 31, 2010.


This resolution shall be in full force and effect as approved by the Council on January 21, 2010.




