

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2012-09**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL TO SUPPORT THE DESIGNATION OF AN ARTS AND CULTURAL DISTRICT IN THE VILLAGE OF NASHVILLE TO BE NAMED THE NASHVILLE ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, a Nashville Cultural District has been designated to assist the district and community to develop a public-private partnership to support said district; and

**WHEREAS**, Nashville Town Council President Bob Kirlin has signed a letter of support for a Nashville Arts and Cultural District;

**WHEREAS**, the Indiana Arts Commission will be petitioned to designate the Nashville Arts District as a Statewide Cultural District:

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED** that the Nashville Town Council:

1. The District is bounded on the West by Jefferson St., on the North by the commercial district just North of Mound St., heads East to include the Brown County Public Library then South to include the Brown County Art Gallery on Artist Drive and the Brown County High School, then West on School House Lane to meet Jefferson St. again. See attached Exhibit A.
2. Supports the exploration of, and participation in the arts and culture in the Nashville Arts and Cultural District through a wide variety of art and cultural experiences unique to Nashville.
3. Endorses the goals of economic vitality and enhancing community life through participation in the development and financial support of the Nashville Arts and Cultural District.
4. Will encourage the Nashville Redevelopment Commission to develop incentives to stimulate and encourage the vitality of the Nashville Arts and Cultural District.
5. Will appoint a town official to represent the town of Nashville on the governing board of the Nashville Arts and Cultural District.
6. Directs Nashville town staff to actively support and cooperate with the governing board to develop, maintain and encourage the economic vitality and sustainability of the Nashville Arts and Cultural District.
7. The Nashville Arts and Entertainment Commission will support and work directly with the Nashville Arts and Cultural District.
