**WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and


**WHEREAS**, an adopted multi-hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Nashville participated jointly in the planning process with the other local units of government within the County to prepare a Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan;






