WHEREAS, the Town will secure two disinterested appraisers to furnish appraisals of the properties, the average of which is to be equal to or greater than the purchase price.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Town Council that the Town Administration and the Clerk-Treasurer take all steps necessary for financing and purchase of the properties.


