# A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A NASHVILLE PARK IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Indiana, establishes the Nashville Park Improvement Fund to be governed by the applicable statutory provisions;

WHEREAS, funds were left over from the original Place Based Investment Fund grant dollars and the Town is permitted to use these dollars on future park improvement endeavors (see Attachment A); and

**WHEREAS**, the life of the fund shall continue until the Town Council of the Town of Nashville decides otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the fund balance shall be perpetual until terminated by the terms of the current resolution or by enactment of a subsequent resolution or amendment; and

**WHEREAS**, the disposition of the fund balance on termination of the fund will be determined by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** by the Council of the Town of Nashville that a Nashville Park Improvement Fund be established for the specific purpose of supporting and maintaining Town Parks.
