RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE, INDIANA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A CDBG COVID-19 RESPONSE PROGRAM-PHASE 3 GRANT APPLICATION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits: and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding associated with the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) which was signed into law in March 2020, for relief of needs resulting from the Coronavirus Pandemic, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the economic development needs of low-and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the economic needs of its low-and moderate-income residents:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Nashville, Indiana that:

- 1. The Town Council President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the need for economic development grants to businesses impacted or affected by the Coronavirus pandemic to assist in the retention of jobs and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. The Town of Nashville, Indiana hereby commits local funds in the amount of *Six Thousand, Two Hundred, Fifty Dollars* (\$6,250.00), in the form of Professional Fees Account as grant administration funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CDBG COVID-19 Response Program, Phase 3 funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
